PROCESS TO OBTAIN A STUDENT VISA

1

1. Go to your nearest Spanish consulate or embassy and ask for the requirements for visa type D student. For this you will need to dispose of the amount of time you will study abroad.

A. More than 6 months: Visa type D Student (open) before you leave your original country.

B. Less than 6 months: Visa type D Student for 180 days, before leaving you original country, and once in Spain no additional legal actions needs to be made.

In the case A: Once you enter the EU, you have up to 30 days to request the Study Permit Authorization (It is vital you save your flight boarding pass or arrival stamp received in immigration upon your arrival)

Once you arrive please visit the **International Welcome Point at the UAB Bellaterra Campus** to find out how to receive this authorization.

2. **Gather all the requirements** (consult the consul, as every case may be different). It is asolutely necessary to have the **UAB admission letter** that has been sent to you for this step.

3. **Present all the required documents** at the consulate (Please calculate 2 to 4 weeks from your appointment to resolution)
